SMOKE-FREE DRUG-FREE POLICY

June 2004

Rationale:

To ensure that children are given healthy role models and are kept safe from harm.

Purpose:

Playcentre buildings and grounds will be smoke-free 24 hours per day 7 days per week. All adults responsible for the care of children will be drug free.

Procedures

- 1. No person will smoke in the buildings or grounds at any time including sessions, meetings, fundraising events, social activities, working bees etc.
- 2. Any person smoking directly outside the grounds shall do so in a discreet manner out of sight of the children.
- 3. A smoke-free environment will be maintained for the duration of any trip or excursion run as a licensed session.
- 4. No smoking signs will be displayed at every entry gate to the grounds and building.
- 5. Any group using the Playcentre buildings or grounds will be informed of this policy.
- 6. Any person smoking in contravention of this policy will be asked to stop or to leave.
- 7. No person under the influence of alcohol or any illegal mind-altering substance will be allowed on the premises during session times.
- 8. Any person on the premises during session times who is under the influence of alcohol or any illegal mind-altering substance will be asked to leave.
- 9. No child will be released into the care of any person affected by alcohol or illegal mindaltering substances.
